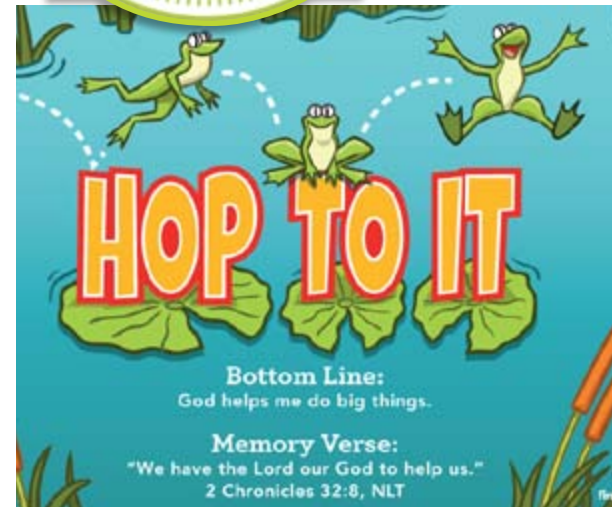
Also, please remember this will be our last breakfast before the summer break so lets have a big crowd. We will start back up in August of 2019.
