
Lunch & Learn Event Draws Crafty Crowd

Youth Ministry News


This year has been so much fun with a small, but dedicated group of teenagers in our Youth Ministry! On Wednesday nights we have enioved 2D Worship, then games and small group.




Special thanks to Nathan and Kristen LaShoto for leading small group on Wednesdays. We wrapped up our year with an ultimate paint ball adventure
